SERVICES OF FUNERAL DIRECTOR AND STAFF \$ 1235.00

Our fee for the services of funeral director and staff includes, but is not limited to, consultation with family and clergy, arrangement and direction desired, preparation and filing of necessary permits and notices (\$30 extra if second signature is required on death certificate), authorizations and consents, local telephone service, handling and care of floral tributes, and other services and attendance prior to, during and following the funeral including coordinating with those providing other portions of the funeral, e.g. cemetery, crematory, and others. Also included in this charge are overhead expenses relative to our facility such as insurance, maintenance, utility expenses, secretarial and administrative costs, equipment and inventory expenses.

This fee for our basic services and overhead will be added to the total cost of the funeral arrangements you select.

Extra Staff for large services, each staff (incl. parking assistants) \$ 65.00

PREPARATION OF THE REMAINS

EMBALMING \$ 245.00

Except in certain special cases, embalming is not required by law. Embalming may be necessary, however, if you select certain funeral arrangements, such as a funeral with viewing. If you do not want embalming, you usually have the right to choose an arrangement that does not require you to pay the embalming charge, such as a direct cremation or immediate burial. (Some mausoleums may require embalming for entombment.)

[†]Cremation can only take place after proper signatures and permits are obtained by mortuary. Normally, it can be completed within 3 full working days after a death has occurred. There will be an extra charge (\$100) if cremation **must** be done in less time.

*Any remains weighing 300 to 349 pounds will require an additional charge of \$100 plus an adequate container (solid platform 3'x6'8") for use with specialized lifting equipment. In the case of remains weighing 350 pounds or more, there will be another additional charge of \$1 per pound. Please understand that this is not a discriminatory statement. These charges are to insure the safe handling of the body, including an additional staff, a full-time onsite attendant and equipment required for the cremation/handling process.

NOTE: These prices do not include cemetery charges.
